

BREXIT CUSTOMS REQUIREMENTS

FROM JAN 1ST 2021

Effective January 1st 2021, all goods moving between Mainland UK and Ireland (Europe) will require customs clearance on export & import IRL/UK/IRL To enable IE Distribution to arrange UK shipment (import & export), we will require the following information.

- The Importer and Exporter should both be registered for EORI.
 - o Ireland - <https://www.revenue.ie/en/online-services/services/common/register-for-an-eori-number.aspx>
 - o UK - <https://www.gov.uk/eori/apply-for-eori>

- Share a commercial invoice containing the following
 - o Full Name and Address of Consignor / Consignee
 - o EORI Number of both Consignor and Consignee (XI for NI)
 - o Invoice Number, PO Number & Date of Invoice
 - o Currency of the invoice
 - o Price per Item of Goods and Total Price of the Invoice
 - o Description of Goods (Including Commodity Code)
 - o Incoterm (CIF, Ex Works, FOB etc.)
 - o Packaging Details - # of Pieces, Gross & Net Weight
 - o Country of Origin of goods (goods may be liable for import DUTY if their origin is outside UK/Europe)
